APPLICATION FEES)**

Under IDAPA 13.01.08.261.04, the fees for applications for the “Super Hunt” and “Super Hunt Combo” Special Controlled Hunt Program are the same as controlled hunt application fees set in Section 36-416 unless the Commission discounts these fees pursuant to its authority under Idaho Code 36-415. Funds from this program are used to support a sportsman access program. Pursuant to its authority under Idaho Code Section 36-415, upon a finding of public need to optimize revenue from application fees for the Special Controlled Hunt Program, the Commission voted at its July 30, 2015 meeting to adopt a uniform, discounted fee for each Special Controlled Hunt application, incorporating the vendor issuance fee.

At the Commission’s meeting on July 23, 2020, the Administration Bureau advised the Commission regarding the effect of the 2015 discount on program revenues and participation and advised the Commission that a uniform, discounted fee had been beneficial for program revenue.

Pursuant to its authority under Idaho Code Section 36-415, upon a finding of public need to optimize revenue from application fees for the Special Controlled Hunt Program, the Commission voted at its July 23, 2020 meeting to continue a uniform, discounted fee for each Special Controlled Hunt application, incorporating the vendor issuance fee.

ORDER


THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS:

1. The fee for each 2020 through 2022 “Super Hunt” Special Controlled Hunt application be set at \$6.00, including the vendor issuance fee; and
2. The fee for each 2020 through 2022 “Super Hunt Combo” Special Controlled Hunt application be set at \$20.00, including vendor issuance fees.

This order is effective from August 11, 2020 through August 10, 2022, for each application for the 2020 through 2022 “Super Hunt” and “Super Hunt Combo” Special Controlled Hunt.
